Work with experienced archaeologists and bioarchaeologists to excavate human skeletons from an historic cemetery in central Ohio (HTCC). This burial ground was for the local community and later for victims of two cholera outbreaks.



YOU WILL be taught how to:

- Identify grave locations, human bones
- Excavate the skeletons
- Inventory and pack the bones
- Understand stratigraphy and data recording methods
- Complete official site paperwork

Why excavate?

- To shed new light on the lives of individuals too poor to be visible in official histories.
- To understand a disease that killed millions during the 19th century, and is still found in the developing world.
